In addition to the performance characteristics of the Standard range, Medicare Plus is resistant to diluted solutions of ammonia, chlorine, quaternary ammonium and hydrogen peroxide. It also embodies enhanced hygiene and dirt resistance with its bacteriological M1, NF S 90-351:2013 classification.


